Dear Families:

We have opened Kindergarten registration for next year. Children who will be five years old on or before August 31, 2022, are eligible to enter Kindergarten in the fall of 2022. All students who are entering Kindergarten must register, including those already enrolled in our Little Lancers Preschool program. **Registration forms are available [online](#) and should be submitted electronically with all required supporting documentation. All materials are due by March 18, 2022.**

When registering your child, you must also submit the following documents. Please note that these requirements are mandatory, and your child will not be admitted into school prior to submission of these items. All documents must be uploaded as a readable pdf or png (picture format) to complete the registration process

1. A copy of your child's birth certificate from the town you were living in at the time of your child's birth. Hospital certificates will not be accepted.
2. Verification of Residency. (ONE of the following documents):
 - a. Utility bill
 - b. Signed Purchase and Sale (occupancy must take place within sixty (60) days)
 - c. Real Estate Tax Bill
3. Certificate of Physical Examination. It is mandatory to include an up-to-date record of immunization (as listed on the health record), lead testing and official vision screening by a pediatrician or ophthalmologist. The completed physical form must be returned with your registration. If your child has any appointments between then and August 31st, the updated form will be required for admittance.
4. Legal court documentation of guardianship (if applicable) - If divorced or separated, you will need to show legal or official court documentation indicating that you are the custodial parent and have physical custody of your child.
5. Parent/Guardian Photo Identification (copy of license)

This spring parents and guardians will be invited to join us for a Kindergarten Open House. The building principals will be available to answer your questions about our Kindergarten program and offer you information about your child's school.
